Monday 6 November—9.00 Street painting in Dwellingup—as late or as early as you like!

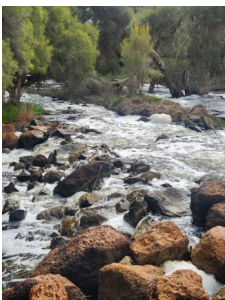

Wednesday 8 November—Boddington townsite



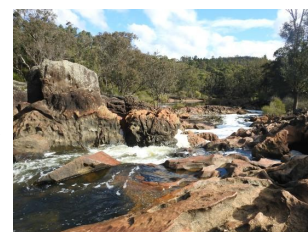
From the main road through Boddington (Bannister Road) turn left into Wuraming Avenue. Here you will find the old school which is very paintable, the Arts Centre and the Visitor's Centre which has a good café. Park up and wander down to the river—to the left is the Lions Weir and to the right is the Hotham Bridge. Whacky sculptures everywhere, a paperbark forest, ducks etc. Loads of places to sit, free barbeques. Stay the morning or stay the day—up to you. There are 3 or 4 places to eat and drink.



Thursday 9 November—9.30am Lane Poole Reserve



Dwaarlindjirraap area—the plein air painters paradise! A lovely place by the river with decking, seating and barbecues so if the weather is good to us, bring along sausages etc for a barbecue lunch! There is a fee to enter the reserve—\$15 per car (\$8 concession) so best to pool cars. Loads of bird-life and views all around, moving water, still water, rocks—birdlife.....magic place.....
